



Standards for Classification and Labeling of Chemical Substances and Material Safety Data Sheet (MoEL Public Notice No. 2020-130)

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Chapter 1 General Provisions

Article 1 (Objective) The objective of this notice is to define the matters necessary pertaining to classification of chemical substances, Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS), approval on the use of alternative information, warning labels and employee training, etc. pursuant to Article 104, Article 110 to Article 116 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Article 86 of the Enforcement Decree of the Act, Article 141, Article 156 to Article 171 and the Appendix 18 of the Enforcement Rules of the Act.

Article 2 (Definitions) ① The terms used in this notice shall be defined as follows:

1. “Chemical substance” means substances produced as a result of a chemical reaction of chemical elements.
2. “Mixture” means a substance or a solution composed of two or more chemical substances.
3. “Manufacture” means the production, processing or mixing of chemical substances or mixtures for purposes of use, transfer or provision.
4. “Import” means the import of chemical substances or mixtures from overseas for purposes of use, transfer or provision.
5. “Container” means anything made of composite steel, plastic, storage tank, glass, vinyl bags, paper bags, etc. that directly contain chemical substances or mixtures in solid, liquid, or gas form. However, a concrete mixer truck or cargo container shall not be deemed as a container.
6. “Packaging” means wrapping or packing containers under Subparagraph 5.
7. “Container for semi-finished products” refers to a container that contains chemical substances or mixtures for purposes of inter-process transfer, which is not a regular case in the workplace.

② In addition, the deification of terms used in this notice, if no special provision indicated, shall be in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act (hereafter referred to as the “Act”), and its Enforcement Decree (hereafter referred to as the “Decree”) and Enforcement Rules (hereafter referred to as the “Rules”)



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
