DECREE

On The Lists Of Chemicals Governed By The Law On Chemicals

Pursuant to Law on Government Organization No. 63/2025/QH15;

Pursuant to Law on Chemicals No. 69/2025/QH15;

*Pursuant to the Law on Prevention and Control of Narcotic Substances
No. 73/2021/QH15;*

At the request of the Minister of Industry and Trade;

*The Government hereby promulgates a Decree on the Lists of chemicals governed by the
Law on Chemicals.*

Article 1. Regulatory scope

This Decree provides the lists of chemicals governed by the Law on Chemicals regarding fields of chemical industry development, chemical-related operations, and safety and security in chemical-related operations. To be specific: Clause 2 Article 6; point a clause 1 Article 9; point a Clause 2 Article 9; clause 2 Article 37.

Article 2. Regulated entities

Domestic agencies, organizations or individuals and foreign organizations or individuals performing activities related to fields of chemical industry development, chemical-related operations, and safety and security in chemical-related operations within the territory of Vietnam.

Article 3. Lists of chemicals governed by the Law on Chemicals

The lists of chemicals governed the Law on Chemicals in the Appendices enclosed with this Decree are as follows: List of basic chemicals in the key chemical industry field (Appendix I); List of chemicals subject to conditional production and trading (Appendix II); List of chemicals requiring special control (Appendix III); List of chemicals for which a chemical incident prevention and response plan (chemical accident management plan) must be developed (Appendix IV).

Article 4. Effect

This Decree comes into force from the day on which it is signed.

Article 5. Organization of implementation

1. Ministers, Heads of ministerial agencies, Heads of Governmental agencies, Chairpersons of the People's Committees of provinces and central-affiliated cities are responsible for implementation of this Decree.
2. Ministries and ministerial agencies shall, within their jurisdiction, review and propose adjustments and updates to the lists of chemicals enclosed herewith to the Ministry of Industry and Trade before June 30 of each year. The Ministry of Industry and Trade shall organize assessment of impacts and send a comprehensive report to the Government for consideration and decision making.
3. Ministries and ministerial agencies shall manage chemical-related operations in sectors and fields under their management.
