- The content for classification based on Test O.3 is added (see 4.2 and Appendix A).

Specification for classification and labelling of chemicals – Part 15: Oxidizing solids

1 Scope

This document specifies the classification criteria, decision logic and guidance, and labelling of oxidizing solids.

This document is applicable to the classification and labelling of oxidizing solids in accordance with the *United Nations Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals* (Rev. 11) (hereinafter referred to as GHS).

4 Classification criteria

4.1 The general principles for the classification and labelling of oxidizing solids are given in GB 30000.1.

4.2 Oxidizing solids are classified into three categories on the basis of its oxidizing properties determined in accordance with the methods described in GB/T 21617, as shown in Table 1.



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
