



Regulation of Labelling Cosmetics Precautions for Use and Fragrance Allergens

Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of this standard is to prescribe the allergy-causing ingredients whose name and usage precautions shall be additionally marked or labeled on the cosmetic packaging as delegated by Article 10 (1) and (4) of the *Cosmetics Act* and Article 19 (3) and (6), Attached Table 3, and Attached Table 4 of the *Enforcement Rule of the Cosmetics Act* (Hereafter referred to as the *Rule*).

Article 2 (Other usage precautions) The "other usage precautions concerning cosmetic safety information that shall be marked or labeled as delegated and published by the Minister of Food and Drug Safety" in subparagraph 2 (b) 15) of the Attached Table 3 under the *Rule* are listed in Attached Table 1.

Article 3 (Allergy-causing Ingredients subject to Marking or labeling) The allergy-causing ingredients in fragrance as prescribed in the subparagraph 3 (e) of Attached Table 3 under the *Rule*, whose names are required to be marked or labeled are specified in the Attached Table 2.

Article 4 (Re-review of clauses) Examination and improvement of the regulation feasibility shall be done every three years (taking January 1, 2014 as the base date and ending December 31 of the third year) in accordance with Article 8 of
