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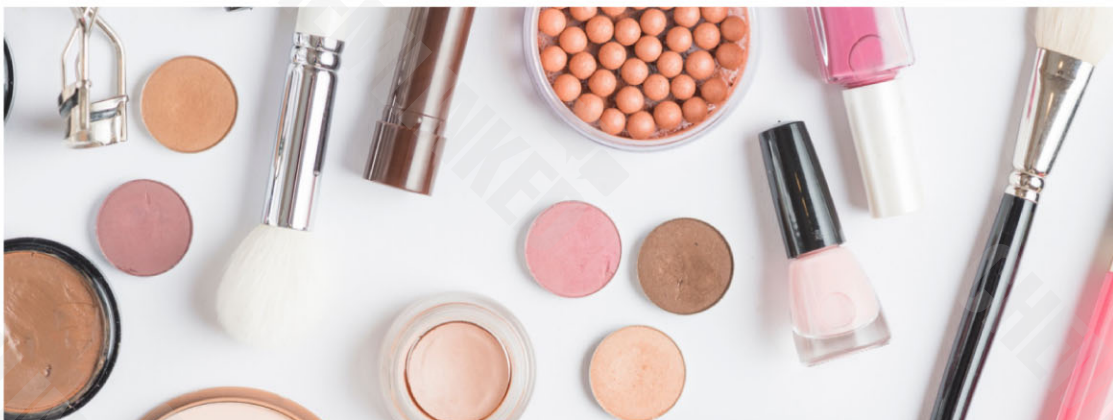
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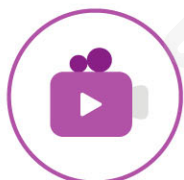


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Guidelines for Submitting Information through the Cosmetic Ingredient

Safety Information Submission Platform

Article 1 To implement the entity responsibility of enterprises for quality and safety and ensure the quality and safety of cosmetic products, the *Guidelines* is hereby developed in accordance with the *Cosmetic Supervision and Administration Regulations*, *Administrative Measures on Cosmetic Registration and Notification* (hereinafter referred to as the *Measures*), *NMPA Announcement on Further Optimizing Measures for Cosmetic Ingredient Safety Information Administration (No. 34 of 2023)* and other relevant regulations.

Article 2 To facilitate enterprises in submitting cosmetic safety information, the National Medical Products Administration (NMPA) has established a Cosmetic Ingredient Safety Information Submission Platform (hereinafter referred to as the "Ingredient Platform"), mainly used for the unified submission of safety information related to existing cosmetic ingredients included in the *Inventory of Existing Cosmetic Ingredients in China 2021* (hereinafter referred to as the *IECIC*).

Article 3 The *Guidelines* aims to guide ingredient manufacturers to standardize the use of the Ingredient Platform. For ingredients with independent serial numbers in the *IECIC*, it is applicable for submitting safety information thereof on the Ingredient Platform.

Article 4 Ingredient manufacturers shall submit ingredient safety information through the Ingredient Platform in accordance with relevant regulations and technical specifications, and shall be responsible for the authenticity and completeness of the submitted ingredient safety information contents.

Article 5 Cosmetic ingredient manufacturers may choose to independently submit cosmetic ingredient safety information, or authorize an overseas or domestic corporate enterprise to undertake the work of submitting ingredient safety information and routine maintenance. For ingredients of the same quality specification, only one enterprise can be authorized to submit the safety related information.

Cosmetic ingredient manufacturers refer to enterprises that are responsible for the safety of ingredients. They can be the actual production enterprises of ingredients, affiliated
