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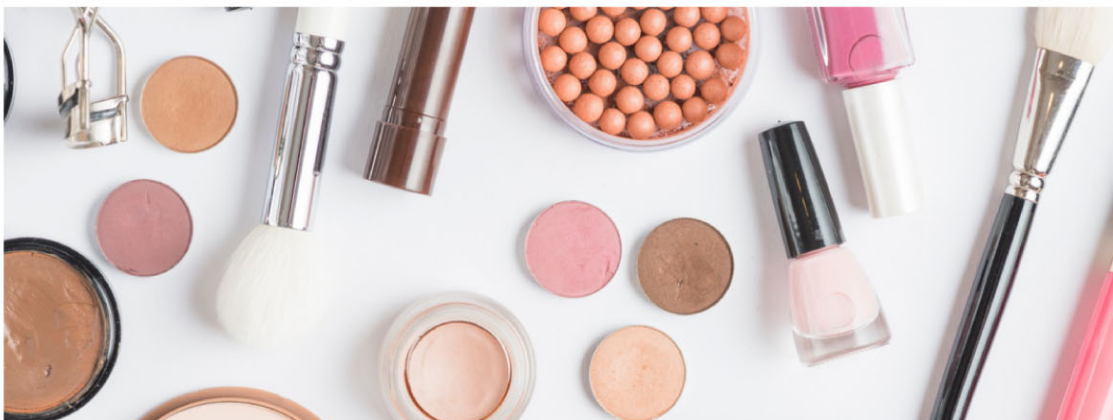

**Guidelines for Research and Determination of Safe Consumption History
of New Cosmetic Ingredients (Trial)**

(Draft for Comments)

I. Overview

According to the *Provisions for Management of New Cosmetic Ingredient Registration and Notification Dossiers* (hereinafter referred to as the "*Dossier Provisions*"), new ingredients applied for registration or handled for notification are categorized into six different situations based on their functions, use history, and consumption history, and requirements for corresponding toxicological test items are proposed based on risk management concepts. Situation 5 is applicable to new cosmetic ingredients with a history of safe consumption. The history of safe consumption of ingredients can serve as available information or data for relevant toxicological endpoints (e.g. systemic toxicity) to a certain extent, reducing the corresponding toxicological test items. In safety assessments, the use safety of ingredients in cosmetics can be analyzed and assessed by combining the adopted history of safe consumption and relevant information and data for the ingredients.

This *Guidelines* is developed in accordance with the requirements of the *Cosmetic Supervision and Administration Regulations (CSAR)*, *Administrative Measures on Cosmetic Registration and Notification, Dossier Provisions*, and other relevant regulations for the purpose of standardizing the research and evaluation of new cosmetic ingredients, guiding the collection, determination, and application in safety assessments of safe consumption history related data and information, and instructing registrants and notifiers to reasonably select the corresponding situations when applying for registration or handling notification of new ingredients.

This *Guidelines* is developed based on current regulations and standards, and level of scientific understanding, and its applicability shall follow the principle of specific analysis of specific issues. Adjustments will be made to this *Guidelines* in a timely manner with the update and improvement of regulations and standards, and development of science and technology.

II. Application Scope

This *Guidelines* shall be applicable to the research and determination of safe consumption history of new cosmetic ingredients (i.e. Situation 5 of the *Dossier Provisions*).

Registrants and notifiers of new cosmetic ingredients shall apply this *Guidelines* as per relevant regulations and technical standards. If there are other applicable technical guidelines or guiding principles, relevant technical requirements or suggestions shall also be referred to.

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
