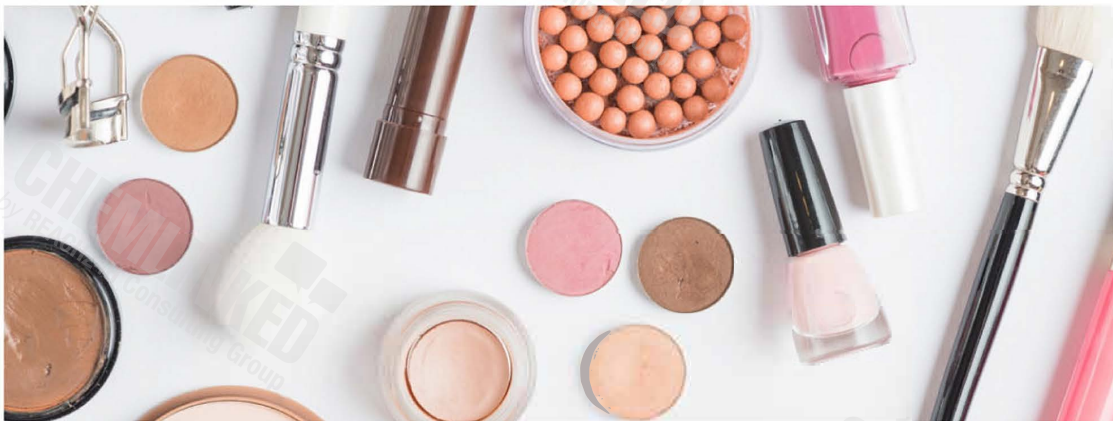

I. Introduction

In accordance with the *Cosmetic Supervision and Administration Regulations (CSAR)*, anti-hair loss cosmetics are classified as special cosmetics and subject to registration management. For the purpose of standardizing and guiding research on anti-hair loss cosmetics, these guidelines are hereby formulated.

These guidelines are formulated based on existing regulations and standards, and the current level of scientific cognition. Relevant content will be adjusted in a timely manner with the continuous improvement of regulations and standards, and the development of science and technology.

II. Application Scope

In accordance with the interpretive notes and claim guides outlined in the *Cosmetic Classification Rules and Catalog* (hereinafter referred to as the *Classification Catalog*), anti-hair loss mainly refers to helping improve or reduce hair loss, and products with such efficacy are managed as special cosmetics; anti-hair breakage refers to helping improve or reduce hair breakage and splitting, maintaining or enhancing hair tenacity, and products with such efficacy are managed as general cosmetics. Products that regulate hormone impacts and promote hair growth do not belong in cosmetics. These guidelines apply to the research on anti-hair loss cosmetics.

Registration applicants shall apply these guidelines under the premise of complying with relevant laws, administrative regulations, mandatory national standards, and technical standards. If there are other applicable technical guidelines, the technical requirements in the corresponding guidelines shall also be referred to simultaneously.

III. General Principles

The research on anti-hair loss cosmetics shall comprehensively judge based on formulas, efficacies, *etc.*, of products to determine whether they belong to anti-hair loss cosmetics. Registration applicants shall conduct thorough research on anti-hair loss cosmetics surrounding the technical content such as product quality, safety, efficacies, and labeling claims in compliance with relevant provisions including the *CSAR*, the *Administrative Provisions on Cosmetic Registration and Notification Dossiers* (hereinafter referred to as the *Dossier Administrative Provisions*), the *Working Rules for Cosmetic Registration and Notification Testing* (hereinafter referred to as the *Testing Rules*), the *Safety and Technical Standards for Cosmetics (STSC)*, the *Standards for Cosmetic Efficacy Claim Evaluation*,
