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Administrative Measures for Imported Feed and Feed Additives Registration

Article 1 For the purpose of strengthening the supervision and administration of imported feed and feed additives and ensuring the quality and safety of animal products, these Measures are hereby formulated in accordance with the *Regulations on Administration of Feed and Feed Additives*.

Article 2 The “feed” mentioned in these Measures refers to the products that are industrially processed and produced for animal consumption, including single feed, premixed feed with additives, concentrated feed, compound feed and concentrated feed supplements.

The “feed additives” mentioned in these Measures refer to a small or trace amount of substances added in the process of feed processing, production, and use, including nutritive feed additives and general feed additives.

Article 3 When an overseas enterprise exports feed and feed additives to China for the first time, it shall apply to the Ministry of Agriculture for the import registration and obtain an import registration certificate for feed and feed additives; for those fail to obtain an import registration certificate, their feed and feed additives shall not be sold or used in China.

Article 4 Overseas enterprises applying for import registration shall ask their work offices stationed in China or commission an agency in China to handle relevant matters.

Article 5 Feed and feed additives subject to application for import registration shall comply with the relevant laws and regulations and technical specifications of the place of production and China.

For feed and feed additives that have not been approved for or prohibited from production, use by the place of production, no registration shall be approved.

Article 6 For application for import registration of feed and feed additives, the true, complete and standardized application documents (in both Chinese and English, in duplicate) and relevant samples shall be submitted to the Ministry of Agriculture.

Article 7 Application documents shall include:

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- (I) Registration application form for import of feed and feed additives;
- (II) Letter of authorization and agency qualification certificate: If an overseas enterprise commissions its resident representative office in China for registration, it shall provide the original letter of authorization and a copy of the *Registration Certificate of Resident Representative Office in China of Overseas Enterprise*; for commissioning of other domestic agencies for registration, the original letter of authorization and a copy of the business license of the agency's legal person shall be provided;
- (III) Certificate of approval for production and use at the place of production, registration information of other countries and regions outside the place of production, and product promotion and application;
- (IV) Product name, composition, physical and chemical properties, application scope, and application method of imported feed; product name, main components, physical and chemical properties, product source, intended purpose, application scope, and application method of imported feed additives;
- (V) Production process, quality standards, testing methods and testing reports;
- (VI) Labels, trademarks used at the place of production and Chinese label styles;
- (VII) For microbiological products or fermented products, a preservation certificate of strain used for production shall also be provided.

Whoever exports feed and feed additives prescribed in Article 13 of these Measures to China shall also submit the following application documents:

- (I) The chemical structure identification report of the effective components or the classification identification report of animals, plants and microorganisms;
- (II) Product effectiveness evaluation testing report and safety evaluation testing report (including target animal tolerance evaluation report, toxicology safety evaluation report, metabolism and residue evaluation report, etc.) issued by the testing institution that is designated by the Ministry of Agriculture; whoever applies for import registration of feed additive shall also provide an analysis and evaluation report on the possible impact of the feed additive residue in the aquaculture product on human health;
- (III) Stability testing report and environmental impact report;
- (IV) Where there is a maximum limit requirement for feed products, the maximum limit value and the testing method of the effective components in the feed products shall be



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
