Foreword

This standard replaces GB 2761–2017 National Food Safety Standard – Maximum Levels of Mycotoxins in Foods.

Compared with GB 2761–2017, the main changes of this standard are as follows:

- Notes 1 and 2 of the edible part have been deleted;
- The aflatoxin B₁ limit has been modified;
- The aflatoxin M₁ limit has been modified;
- The deoxynivalenol limit has been modified;
- The fumonisin limit has been added;
- The conversion ratio of liquid infant and young child formula has been added;
- The note of "except for hawthorn roll" in Table 4 has been deleted;
- Annex A has been modified.
