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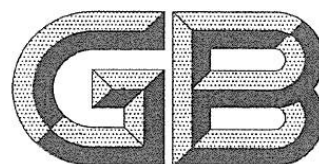

National Food Safety Standard

Complementary Food Supplements

1. Scope

This standard is applicable to complementary food supplements intended for consumption by infants and young children from 6 months old to 36 months old and children from 37 months old to 60 months old.

2. Terms and Definitions

2.1 Complementary foods

Complementary foods

Complementary foods are the foods supplemented for consumption by infants and young children after six months old who are still being breastfed to meet their nutritional needs, including home-made and factory-produced foods.

2.2 Complementary food supplements

Complementary food supplements (CFSs) are a kind of food supplements containing multiple micronutrients (vitamins and minerals, *etc.*), in which food matrixes and other auxiliary materials may or may not be contained. CFSs can either be added to the ready-to-eat complementary foods for infants and young children from 6 months old to 36 months old or be consumed by children from 37 months old to 60 months old. At present, the commonly used forms of CFSs include: nutrient-dense food supplement for complementary feeding, foodlets for complementary food supplements and sprinkles for complementary food supplements.

2.2.1 Nutrient-dense food supplement for complementary feeding

Nutrient-dense food supplement for complementary feeding are complementary food supplements made by one or more kinds of soybean, soybean protein products, milk and milk protein products as food matrixes, with the addition of multiple micronutrients and (or) other auxiliary materials. Such foods can be in powdery or granular or semi-solid form, *etc.* and the food matrixes can provide part of high quality proteins.

2.2.2 Foodlets for complementary food supplements

Foodlets for complementary food supplements are complementary food supplements in flaky form made by one or more kinds of soybean, soybean

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
