I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Scope of regulation

This Regulation prescribes the safety limits of heavy metal contamination in food and related management requirements.

2. Subjects of application

This Regulation applies to:

2.1. Organizations and individuals that import, produce and trade food products at risk of heavy metal contamination.

2.2. Relevant organizations and individuals.

3. Explanation of terms

In this Regulation, the following terms are understood as follows:

3.1. The safe limit is the maximum limit (ML) of a heavy metal contaminant allowed in food.
