

National Food Safety Standard

Paper and Paperboard Materials and Products for Food Contact

1. Scope

This standard applies to paper and paperboard materials and products intended for food contact.

2. Terms and Definitions

2.1 Food contact paper and paperboard materials and products

Under normal conditions of use, various paper and paperboard materials and products that have or are expected to come into contact with food or food additives (hereinafter referred to as food), or whose components may be transferred to food, including waxed paper, silicone paper and pulp molded products.

2.2 Pulp molded products

With pulp as the main raw material, the products are made into the shapes required by product use through processes such as forming, molding, and drying.

3. Basic Requirements

Food contact paper and paperboard materials and products should comply with the requirements of GB 4806.1.

4. Technical Requirements

4.1 Raw material requirements

4.1.1 The raw materials used in food contact paper and paperboard materials and products should not be harmful to human health. The fiber raw materials should be mainly plant fibers, and the synthetic fiber raw materials contained should comply with the requirements of the relevant national food safety standards.

4.1.2 The use of additives in food contact paper and paperboard materials and products shall comply with the provisions of GB 9685 and relevant announcements.
