Considering: that in order to implement the provisions of Article 22 paragraph (2) of the Regulation of the Food and Drug Supervisory Agency Number 1 of 2022 concerning Supervision of Claims on Labels and Advertisements of Processed Food, it is necessary to establish a Decree of the Head of the Food and Drug Supervisory Agency on the Types of Microorganisms That Can Be Used in Processed Food;
