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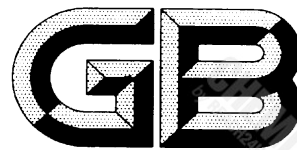
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Preface

This standard replaces GB 10770-2010 National Food Safety Standard Canned Complementary Foods for Infants and Young Children.

Compared with GB 10770-2010, main changes of this standard are as follows:

- Modified the description of scope, terms and definitions;
- Modified the description of the product classification;
- Modified the description of ingredient requirements;
- Added a provision that honey should not be used;
- Added a histamine limit to the physicochemical indicators;
- Adopted general standards for contaminant limits and mycotoxin limits;
- Updated the standard numbers for testing methods;
- Modified the consumption precautions.



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
