Foreword

This standard replaces GB 19645–2005 “Hygienic Standard for Pasteurized and Sterilized Milk” and part of the indicators in GB 5408.1–1999 “Pasteurized Milk”. R Indicators in GB 5408.1–1999 which is associated with this standard shall be subject to this standard.

Compared with GB 19645–2005 the main changes are as follows:

- “Hygienic Standard for Pasteurized and Sterilized Milk” is divided into three standards, namely “Pasteurized Milk”, “Sterilized Milk” and “Formulated Milk”. This standard is named “Pasteurized Milk”;
- The description for “scope” is modified;
- “Terms and definition” is defined;
- Fat requirements for non-fat or low-fat products are removed;
- Protein requirements for goat milk are added;
- Limits of acidity as required in physical and chemical indicators are modified into ranges of value;
- Veterinary drug residue indicators are removed;
- Pesticide residue indicators are removed;
- Contaminant residue limits are directly quoted from GB 2762;
- Fungimycin residue limits are directly quoted from GB 2761;
- Method of expression for microbiological indicators is amended;
- Requirements for food additives are removed;
- Labeling requirements are amended.
