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Preface

This Guidance is formulated based on the Regulation of New and Existing Chemical Substances Registration (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation) promulgated by the Environmental Protection Administration under the Executive Yuan. It aims to provide a detailed explanation of the obligations and responsibilities related to chemical substances registration in the Regulation.

The contents of this Guidance are used to illustrate and explain the relevant provisions of the Regulation, providing guidance on when, where and how to comply with the provisions, as well as substantive suggestions in favor of registrants to fulfill the obligations and responsibilities related to chemical substances registration in the Regulations.

This Guidance is a main supporting document to explain the Regulation. Users shall refer to the Regulation of New and Existing Chemical Substances Registration and fully understand this Guidance. Since part of the guidance involves more in-depth technical information, other Technical Guidance Documents (TGD) will be provided separately. Anyone interested or the registrants may refer to the TGDs to learn about all the procedures of the chemical substance registration in detail.

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
