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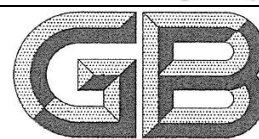

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Foreword

This standard replaces GB 19645–2005 “Hygiene Standard of Pasteurized milk and Sterilized milk”, and part of the requirements involved in GB5408.1–1999 “Pasteurized milk” and GB 5408.2–1999 “Sterilized milk”. The relevant requirements in GB5408.1–1999 “Pasteurized milk” and GB 5408.2–1999 “Sterilized milk” shall comply with the equivalents in this standard.

Compared with GB 19645–2005, the main modification is:

- “Hygiene Standard of Pasteurized milk and Sterilized milk” is divided into three standards: “Pasteurized Milk”, “Sterilized Milk” and “Modified Milk”. This document contains “Modified Milk”.

This standard replaces the previous:

1 Scope

This Standard applies to Whole, Semi-skimmed and Skimmed modified milk.

2 Normative references

However, the parties that reached an agreement in this standard were encouraged to research the possibility of using the latest version of these documents. 3 Terms and definitions

3.1 modified milk

Liquid product made using more than 80% cow or sheep milk or recombined milk as main materials, and other ingredients, with or without the addition of food additives and nutritional fortification substances, gone through the process of Pasteurization or Sterilization or similar heat treatment.

4 Specifications

4.1 Requirements of raw materials

4.1.1 Raw milk: should meet the requirements set by GB19301.

4.1.2 Other materials: should comply with the corresponding hygiene standards and related regulations.

4.2 Sensory requirements
