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Preface

This standard supersedes GB 13121-1991 Hygienic Standard of Ceramic Tableware container and GB 14147-1993 Permissible Limit of Dissolving-Out Amount for Lead and Cadmium in Ceramic Packaging Container, and corresponding indexes in GB 8058-2003 Permissible Limit of Dissolving-Out Amount and Test Method for Lead and Cadmium in Ceramic Cooker and GB 12651-2003 Permissible Limit of Dissolving-Out Amount for Lead and Cadmium in Ceramic Articles Intended to Come into Contact with Foodstuffs.

The following major changes and modifications can be identified by comparing this standard to the aforesaid standards:

- Change the standard name to “National Standard for Food Safety: Ceramic Articles”;
- Modify the description of scope;
- Add terms and definitions;
- Modify the sensory requirements;
- Modify the physical and chemical indexes;
- Add general requirements on migration tests and modify the migration test conditions;
- Add requirements on labels and marks;

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
