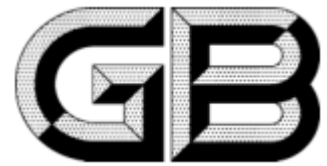

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Foreword

This standard supersedes GB/T 5009.156-2003 *General Principle to the Immersion Test of Materials and Articles for Food Packaging*.

Compared to GB/T 5009.156-2003, this standard has following changes:

- Amend this standard name to "General Principle to the Pretreatment for Migration Test of Materials and Articles in Contact with Food" ;
- Amend terms and definitions;
- Add general principle of testing;
- Add reagents and materials;
- Add equipment and instrument;
- Amend methods for sample collection and preparation;
- Amend the sample contact area;
- Add the ratio of sample contact area to food simulant volume;
- Amend sample cleaning procedure;
- Amend testing method;
- Add determination requirements on migration quantity;
- Amend presentation of results;
- Delete "Annex A Sampling Method of Food Packaging Material" of old standard;
- Delete "Annex B Immersion Testing Items and Test Conditions" of old standard; and
- Add Annexes A, B, C and D.
